NORTHWEST OHIO — Friends of Greg Horstman of Ottoville had to sit by while their comrade fought and lost his lengthy battle with cancer. Horstman was just 31 and left behind a wife and five children.

Seeing the devastation to the Horstman family after losing its patriarch, friend Todd Altenburger and eight others saw a need for financial support for families affected by the illness or death of a loved one. And so, the Make It Enough Foundation was born.

"Our mission is 'To provide direct assistance to Ohio families that are experiencing financial need as the result of an illness or death of a family member'," Foundation Chair Altenburger said of the community-based organization. "We formed legally this year as the result of last year's death of a mutual friend."

Horstman was originally from the Cloverdale area and all nine of the founding board members of the MIEF organization went to Ottoville or Fort Jennings High School.

The organization's first major formal event is going to be a golf scramble on June 17 at the Findlay County Club.

The range opens at 9 a.m. with tee-off at 10:30 a.m. Dinner will be served at 4 p.m. with trophy presentations, the Long-Drive Contest and Closest to Pin winners and silent auction results.
