At 2:31 a.m. on Sunday, Delphos Police were called to a residence in the 227 West Clime Street in reference to an assault at a residence there. Upon officers arrival the victim stated that subjects known to the victim had came to the residence and upon the victim answering the door were assaulted by the subjects.

The case was forwarded to the Prosecutor's Office for review and possible charges.
